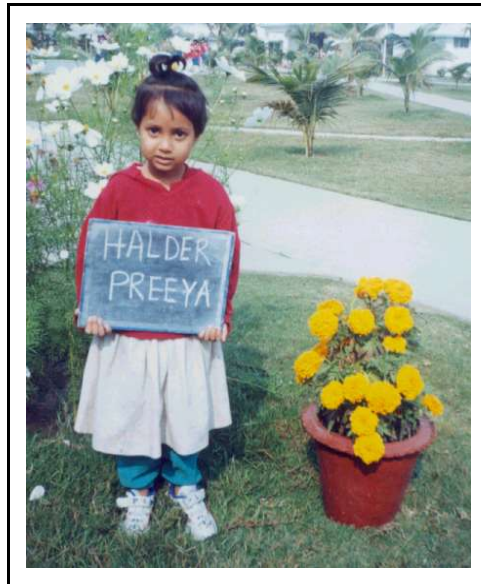

## Preeya

When Dave and I were visiting our college last fall a young couple came to see us. They had a beautiful little girl with them by the name of Preeya. She was three years old. The young man told us he had been taking care of Preeya for the past year but he had recently married and his wife did not want to care for Preeya. Would we please take her into one of our orphanages? He proceeded to tell us he was the cousin of Preeya and that his aunt had become mentally ill and had taken a stick from the fire and burned little Preeya's stomach. (He then showed us the scar on her tummy!) The father took Preeya to his mother's home but then his wife had a baby



boy and he wanted his mother to care for the new baby. She said she could not care for both children. This was why the young man had Preeya! We had him take Preeya to our

SAMS orphanage and the picture shows her there. We are so grateful for wonderful sponsors and donors, like you, who make it possible for little ones like Preeya to find a home where they are loved, cared for and given the opportunity to know Jesus!

# PROJECTS

## 1. SPONSORSHIP FUND

45 Total Village Schools are sponsored with a feeding program included! That means 1,750 children are getting one meal each school day!



## 2. VIDEO FUND

We have 800 promotional videos for showing in our churches!

## 3. EDUCATIONAL FUND

We are having two English reading workshops for village school teachers and two for our boarding school teachers. These are scheduled for January.



## 4. MEDICAL FUND

Three eye operations on students at KMMS. Swapna's cancer treated. Joshna and Sumi, medical help at Spicer. Polina, one of our former students, married and has two small children. She has a large cyst on her ovary. We have been helping her.

## 5. HILLTRACTS FUND

Water has been found at our Hilltracts school.

## 6. CLOTHING FUND

We have two ladies sewing lovely dresses for our girls at our three orphanages. We want to give each orphan a Christmas outfit.



## 7. USE AS NEEDED FUND

We give money for medicine and warm clothes to village children who are in need. We help needy ladies whose husbands have abandoned them.

## 8. NEW BOARDING SCHOOL

We have so many students we have opened a new boarding school in the south! By January there will be around 200 students.

# PROJECT NEEDS

## 1. 185 plus village schools still need sponsorship.

This is approximately 7,400 children! This can be done by sponsoring one child at \$10 a month or \$100 a year. It can be done by someone taking as many students as they can afford, maybe a whole school!

## 2. Free for the asking!

Please call or e-mail and ask for a video to show at your church! We want to triple the amount of schools sponsored in three years. We will send you newsletters to hand out when you show the video.

3. We need English reading textbooks printed in Bangladesh. We need to buy charts, alphabets, and school supplies here to make teaching and learning more attractive and interesting. We want all the schools to have learning aids.

4. It seems there is never enough money when it comes to medical needs. People come to Dave and I all the time! How can we turn them away when we know how desperately they need help? A boy in the Hilltracts school needs a hernia operation. One boy there has teeth sticking out so far he can not close his mouth. More children need eye operations.

5. Water tanks are needed for storage and irrigation. We estimate the remaining cost for completion of the school at \$250,000.

6. The two ladies here do lovely work but it is not enough to furnish all the children with clothing. The quality is NOT as good as here but we can buy clothing there for less than \$10 an outfit, including shoes! We have around 400 orphans in our three orphanages.

7. It's wonderful to have "Use as needed Money" for many of the poor who have unexpected tragedies and no one to turn to..

8. We need a new girl's dorm immediately! The girls are all crowded together in one small room. The estimated cost is \$10,000.
